MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to cancel the certificate of service authority of Conversant Technologies, Inc. (Conversant or Company) and states as follows:

- 1. On September 21, 2009, the Commission granted Conversant a certificate of service authority to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
- 2. On August 12, 2011, the Commission received a Ceasing Operation Statement from the Company that requested the cancellation of its certificate of service authority. (See Attachment A).
- 3. Because the Company requested cancellation of its certificate and it is not providing services in Missouri to the best of the Staff's knowledge, information and belief, the Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate.
- 4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMO 2000, which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

- 5. The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).
- 6. The Company is current on its fiscal year 2012 assessment and submission of its calendar year 2010 annual report.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority and associated tariff of Conversant Technologies, Inc., to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
