ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On May 5, 2005, the Commission granted Emerald Pointe Utility Company a certificate of service authority to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water and sewer system in an unincorporated portion of Taney County, Missouri. That order required Emerald Pointe to file tariff sheets before serving the new area.

These cases remain open, awaiting Emerald Pointe's tariff sheets. The Commission will order its Staff to file a pleading recommending whether these cases should continue to remain open for the tariff sheets, or whether the Commission should close these cases, and open new cases for the tariff sheets.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file a pleading recommending whether the Commission should leave these cases open or close them no later than December 14, 2005.

2. That this order shall become effective on November 14, 2005.
