#### **ORDER EXTENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The previously approved procedural schedule for this case requires the parties – Lake Region Water & Sewer Company, Staff, and Public Counsel – to file a stipulation and agreement by August 11, 2006. Instead, on that date, the parties filed a joint motion asking the Commission to extend the procedural schedule.

The Joint Motion explains that Lake Region was unable to provide certain cost data to Staff in the time required by the procedural schedule. As a result, Staff was unable to complete its audit of that data on time. Because of these delays, the parties have been unable to complete their stipulation and agreement by the day required by the procedural schedule. The Joint Motion asks that the procedural schedule be amended to allow an additional two weeks to file the stipulation and agreement.

The Joint Motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. It will be granted.

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The previously established procedural schedule is extended to provide as

follows:

The parties file a stipulation and agreement	-	August 25, 2006
Staff files suggestions in support of stipulation and agreement	-	September 6, 2006
Other parties file responses, if any, to Staff's supporting suggestions	-	September 11, 2006
