Big Island Water & Sewer Company has filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate a water and sewer system in Camden County, Missouri. On July 20, 2006, the Commission granted the application of Mark and Deborah Hesley to intervene. On November 9, a letter from the Hesleys was filed indicating that they no longer wish to continue as intervenors. No party has responded to that letter.

Since the Hesleys ask to withdraw from this case and no party has opposed that request, the Commission will grant their request and will dismiss them as parties.

1. Mark Hesley and Deborah Hesley are dismissed as parties to this case.
