ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

On June 19, 2008, Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. ("Seges"), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission. It requests a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate a water system.

On August 13, 2008, Staff filed Staff's Request for Correction of Seges Deficient Application and New Date for Staff Recommendation or Status Filing. On August 20, the Commission ordered Seges to supplement its application. The case then lay dormant until December 30, 2008, when the Commission ordered Seges to show cause why its application should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute.

On January 12, 2009, Seges filed an Application For Extend Date to Cure Defeciencies (sic). Seges explained that its counsel failed to failed to inform Seges of its duty to secure a feasibility study. Seges requested the Commission to extend the deadline for Seges to cure its deficiencies to February 13, 2009.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. Staff did not file a response to Seges' application within the ten days; therefore, the Commission will take up the request unopposed.

The Commission finds Seges' request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Application for Extend Date to Cure Defeciencies (sic) filed by Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. is granted.
- 2. Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. shall correct the deficiencies in its application no later than February 13, 2009.
 - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
