ORDER DIRECTING STATUS REPORT

On July 19, 2011, Lincoln County Sewer & Water, L.L.C. filed applications requesting that the Commission grant it Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (“CCNs”) to own, operate, maintain, control and manage water and sewer systems in Lincoln County, Missouri.¹ The Commission issued notice and set an intervention deadline. No entities sought intervention.

At the request of the Commission’s Staff, the Commission held a local public hearing on August 25, 2011. A number of issues were raised at the hearing, which the Commission discussed in its public agenda meeting on August 30, 2011. The Commission will direct its Staff to file a status report to update the Commission on the status of any of the issues raised at the local public hearing and to provide a timeline for when Staff will be able to provide the Commission with a recommendation on the CCN applications.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than September 30, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a status report as described in the body of this order.

¹ The Commission consolidated the separate water and sewer files on August 16, 2011 (File Nos. SA-2012-0019 and WA-2012-0018) and designated File Number WA-2012-0018 as the lead case.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
