OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS**

On July 19, 2011, Lincoln County Sewer & Water, L.L.C. filed applications requesting that the Commission grant it Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (“CCNs”) to own, operate, maintain, control and manage water and sewer systems in Lincoln County, Missouri. The areas generally encompassed by the requested CCNs would include two existing developments (Rockport and Bennington) whose water and sewer systems are not currently regulated by the Commission. The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the County Commission of Lincoln County, Missouri and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

2. The Commission's Public Information Officer shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Lincoln County, Missouri and to the media serving Lincoln County, Missouri.

3. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than August 2, 2011. Such applications shall be filed with:
