**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On January 20, 2015, TUK LLC filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it certificates of convenience and necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain water and sewer systems in Jefferson County, Missouri. On May 22, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation to approve the application subject to several conditions and impose interim rates. The Commission will direct the Company to file a response addressing the conditions and proposed rates in the Staff recommendation. The Commission will also provide an opportunity for other parties to respond to the Staff recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. TUK LLC shall respond to the Staff recommendation, specifically addressing the conditions and proposed interim rates set out therein, no later than June 2, 2015.
2. Any other party wishing to respond to the Staff recommendation shall do so no later than June 2, 2015.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
