On May 22, 2015, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation to approve TUK LLC's application subject to several conditions. The Office of Public Counsel stated that it has no opposition to Staff's recommendation and its suggested conditions, except that it proposed that TUK file a new rate case within 18 months instead of a rate review by Staff after rates become effective. Staff has consented to this revised condition. No party has filed an objection to Staff's recommendation and conditions, as revised.

An order granting a certificate of convenience and necessity was submitted for consideration of the Commission at an agenda meeting on July 22, 2015, but that order was withdrawn at the request of one of the parties due to some disagreement about the proposed conditions. No further action or filings have occurred since the order was withdrawn.

The Commission will require Staff to file a status report to provide information about the current status of the case and whether any parties disagree with the proposed Staff conditions, as revised.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than September 8, 2015, Staff shall file a status report to provide information about the current status of the case and whether any parties disagree with the proposed Staff conditions, as revised.
