**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATES FOR SUBMISSION
OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS AND STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On April 21, 2017, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system in St. Louis County, Missouri. The requested CCN would allow MAWC to provide water service to an existing development known as the Pevely Farms subdivision. The Commission will direct that notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests and Staff recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of St. Louis County, Missouri and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission’s Public Information Officer shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing St. Louis County, Missouri and to the media serving St. Louis County, Missouri.

3. No later than May 9, 2017, Missouri-American Water Company and the Pevely Farms Homeowner Association shall file suggestions on how to provide notice to the customers affected by the proposed transaction.

4. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than May 16, 2017.

5. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Missouri-American Water Company's application no later than June 20, 2017.

6. This order shall be effective when issued.
