**ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES**

On April 21, 2017, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) filed applications with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it Certificates of Convenience and Necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water and sewer system in St. Louis County, Missouri. MAWC also filed a *Motion to Consolidate* in each of these cases, which stated that the above cases involve related questions of law and fact and requested that the Commission consolidate the cases to prevent unnecessary costs and delay. More than ten days have elapsed since the motion was filed, and no party has responded or objected to MAWC’s request.<sup>1</sup> The Commission finds that these actions involve related questions of law and fact and will consolidate these actions pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(3).

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<sup>1</sup> Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) states that “[p]arties shall be allowed ten (10) days from the date of filing in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the commission”.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. File Nos. WA-2017-0278 and SA-2017-0279 are consolidated. All future case submissions shall be made in File No. WA-2017-0278.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
