On February 20, 2015¹, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois ("ATXI") asked the Commission to either find that it does not have jurisdiction over this project or, in the alternative, to grant ATXI a certificate of convenience and necessity to build it. The Commission provided notice and set a deadline for applications to intervene. The Commission received timely intervention requests from United for Missouri, Inc., and Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, which the Commission granted.

The Commission noted that ATXI requests that the Commission rule on this application no later than April 30. Thus, the Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation or an alternative pleading on how it believes the Commission should proceed.

Staff responded as ordered on April 6. Staff stated that it requests until April 20 to file a recommendation. Staff further commented that it had contacted ATXI, and that ATXI does not object to Staff's request.
