STATEMENT OF POSITION
THE CITY OF WARRENSBURG

COMES NOW Intervenor City of Warrensburg ("Warrensburg") by and through counsel, and pursuant to the Commission's Order, issued in the above-captioned case on July 17, 2003, for its Statement of Position states as follows:

1. On Issues 1-20 and 26-38, Warrensburg generally supports the staff, but reserves the right to take a position on any issue after hearing all of the evidence.

Rate Design Issues:

21. What is the appropriate way to allocate costs among MAWC's various operating districts?

The costs for each district should be determined based on the costs directly attributed to the cost of serving that particular district. General and administrative costs (overhead) should be allocated to each of the districts on a reasonable and fair method.

22. What is the appropriate way in which to allocate costs among customer classes within each operating district?

Warrensburg takes no position at this time but reserves the right to take a position after hearing all of the evidence.

23. What is the appropriate way to design rates for each customer class?

Class cost of service pricing should be utilized in each district based on each district's unique cost of service for each class.

24. **Should there be any revenue contribution among districts to mitigate the impact of full, costs of service rates for any district?**


Rate payers in one district should not be required to subsidize service costs in any other district.

25. **Should there be consolidated billing?**

Warrensburg takes no position on this issue at this time, but reserves the right to take a position after hearing all of the evidence.
