ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

Issue Date: January 23, 2018 Effective Date: January 23, 2018

On December 20, 2017, the Commission issued its Report and Order for this case.

On December 29, 2017, the Commission received an application for rehearing from Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC" or the "Company").

Absent a commission authorized deferred accounting mechanism, such as an AAO or a tracker, the filed rate doctrine does not permit the recoupment by a regulated utility of increased costs nor the refunding of over-recovery to ratepayers outside of a general rate case. The Commission may consider prior over or under recovery of a Commission-authorized rate of return when establishing new rates, but such over-recovery cannot be used to refund previously collected funds appropriately collected through a valid tariff.

MAWC's application for rehearing references the recently enacted Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, which, beginning in 2018, lowers MAWC's corporate income tax rate from the 35% rate calculated into the company's current rates to 21%. MAWC argues that the Company's increased property taxes at issue in this case are analogous to the impact of the lowered income tax rate through the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017. The Commission

need not address this argument, but notes that absent a deferred accounting mechanism, the company will continue to collect the amount authorized in its current rates until new tariff sheets go into effect.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2016, states that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, the application does not demonstrate sufficient reason to rehear the matter. The Commission will deny the application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The application for rehearing filed by Missouri-American Water Company is denied.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
