ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINE FOR INTERVENTION APPLICATIONS

On June 26, 2020, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) applied for an accounting authority order to permitting it to accumulate and defer to a regulatory asset for consideration of recovery in future rate case proceedings all extraordinary costs and financial impacts incurred as a result of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, plus associated carrying costs. MAWC also requests, for good cause shown, a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement of 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention applications.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order and MAWC's application to the parties in File No. WR-2017-0285.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order and MAWC's application to the county commissions in MAWC's service territories.
3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of MAWC's application to members of the General Assembly representing residents in MAWC's service territories.

4. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of MAWC's application to news media serving residents of MAWC's service territories.

5. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than July 16, 2020. Any such filing shall be submitted through the Commission's electronic filing and information system or delivered to:
