ORDER SETTING TIME FOR OBJECTIONS

On June 26, 2020, Missouri-American Water Company applied for an accounting authority order to permitting it to accumulate and defer to a regulatory asset for consideration of recovery in future rate case proceedings all extraordinary costs and financial impacts incurred as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, plus associated carrying costs. On October 7, 2020, the parties, with the exception of the City of Riverside and the City of St. Joseph, filed a *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement*. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.115(2)(B)-(C) states that parties have seven days after the filing of a nonunanimous stipulation and agreement to file objections. Failure to file a timely objection constitutes a waiver of that party's right to a hearing and the agreement may be treated as unanimous. The time for objections is set out below.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any objection to the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement* shall be filed no later than October 14, 2020.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
