On March 2, 2016, the Commission issued a Report and Order that granted KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage solar generation facilities in Jackson County, Missouri. That Report and Order will become effective on March 12.

GMO filed a motion on March 3, asking the Commission to correct an error in its Report and Order. Ordered paragraph 2 of that Report and Order incorporates several conditions recommended by Staff. In incorporating the staff recommendations, the Commission inadvertently left out the word "or" from condition f). That condition should state:

f) File with the Commission an evaluation of the Plan required by e) after the Greenwood Solar Facility has operated for a period of five years, **or** before the company's application for a certificate of convenience and necessity for its next utilityscale solar facility.¹
