ORDER REGARDING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICES

Issue Date: July 15, 2014 Effective Date: July 15, 2014

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the motions to:

- Convene a local public hearing ("motion to convene local public hearing"),
- Combine notice of local public hearing with the notice of the proposed tariffs ("motion to combine notices"), and
- Waive the time limit for notice of the proposed tariffs ("motion to waive time limit").

The Commission is reserving ruling as to:

- Setting the time and place of the local public hearing, and
- Suspending the proposed tariffs ("motion to suspend").

On those matters, the Commission will rule by separate order.

Each motion is in *The Office of Public Counsel's Request for Local Public Hearing* ("request"), ¹ filed by the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"). OPC filed the request in response to proposed tariffs ("tariffs"). ² In support of the request, OPC cites the magnitude

of the rate increases under the tariffs, the management of the applicant, and the cost savings from combined notices. The Commission will dispense with the time for responses³ to the request because the notice of tariffs is due to issue five working days from the filing of the tariffs.⁴ This order does not bar any response to the motion to suspend or any suggestion as to setting the local public hearing.

Therefore, the Commission will reserve ruling on setting the time and place of the local public hearing and on the motion to suspend; and will grant the motions to convene a local public hearing, to waive time limit, and to combine notices.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The motions to convene a local public hearing, to waive time limit, and to combine notices, as described in the body of this order, are granted.
 - 2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
