ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion for Extension of Time to File Staff's Recommendation* ("motion").¹ In the motion, Staff seeks an extension of time for filing a recommendation on emergency rate relief for Hickory Hills Water & Sewer, Inc. ("Hickory Hills"). In support, Staff states that the additional time will enhance the quality of Staff's recommendation. The recommendation must address complicated issues, multiple parties, and diverse interests; and Staff asks only an additional business day. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

1. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation, as described in the body of this order, no later than April 7, 2014.
