ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND DIRECTING FILING

On March 6, 2006, Multiband, Inc., applied to the Commission for authority to provide private shared tenant services (STS). Multiband applied under Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, which provides that no telecommunications company not exempt from that subsection shall conduct any business in this state until it has a certificate of service authority.

The Commission issued an Order and Notice on March 14, giving interested parties until April 3 to request intervention. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a/ AT&T Missouri, filed an Application to Intervene on March 31. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. No parties timely responded to AT&T Missouri's request. Therefore, the Commission will take up AT&T Missouri's request unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 governs intervention before the Commission. That rule states that the Commission may allow a party to intervene if the proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the application, and in light of no parties objecting to AT&T Missouri's request, the Commission finds that AT&T Missouri has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or that granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

The Commission notes that on April 7, its Staff recommended that the Commission grant Multiband's application. The Commission will give AT&T Missouri until April 21 to respond to Staff's pleading.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri's Application to Intervene is granted.

2. If Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, wishes to respond to the Staff Recommendation, it must do so no later than April 21, 2006.

3. This order shall become effective on April 11, 2006.
