## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: February 16, 2018

Effective Date: February 26, 2018

On February 1, 2018, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Net One International, Inc.'s ("Net One") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TO-2000-265, the Commission granted Net One a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

Staff states in its motion that Net One contacted Staff via letter stating it was no longer providing service in Missouri and requesting the Commission cancel its certificate of service authority. Staff noted that Net One is deficient in the filing of the Company's 2016 Statement of Revenue. Net One is also delinquent on its payment of its fiscal year 2017 assessment. Staff recommends the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, and the company's accompanying tariff.

On February 2, 2018, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond, allowing parties until February 13, 2018, to file an objection or request a hearing. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”


Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Net One International, Inc., shall be canceled.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to Net One International, Inc., in File Number TO-2000-265, is canceled.
2. Net One International, Inc.’s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on February 26, 2018.

4. This case may be closed on February 27, 2018.
