ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
FILE STATEMENT OF UNRESOLVED ISSUES

The procedural schedule established for this arbitration requires the parties to file a revised statement of unresolved issues on April 22, 2005. On that date, the parties, CD Telecommunications, LLC and CenturyTel of Missouri LLC / Spectra Communications, Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel, filed a joint motion asking for an extension of time to file that statement. The motion explains that the parties continue to negotiate to reduce the issues between them and that they are making significant progress toward that goal. They ask that they be allowed until May 2 to file the revised statement of unresolved issues.

The Joint Motion for Extension of Time is reasonable and will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Joint Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
2. That the procedural schedule is modified to provide that the parties shall file a revised statement of unresolved issues on May 2, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on April 25, 2005.
