**ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS
AND DIRECTING NOTICE**

On January 30, 2018, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") submitted proposed tariff sheets designed to implement a general rate increase for electrical service.¹ In a February 8 order, the Commission directed Staff to consult with the other parties to file recommendations regarding the times, dates, and locations for local public hearings. Staff responded on March 2, offering suggested times and locations for such hearings. The Commission will adopt the local public hearing schedule proposed by the parties.

The Commission will direct GMO to provide notice of the hearings to its customers using the notice language described in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informational presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of each local public hearing.

2. GMO, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall each prepare a one-page statement outlining their current assessment of the case, and shall bring sufficient copies for distribution at the question-and-answer session that begins each local public hearing.

3. GMO, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer session.

4. Any other party, at its discretion, may prepare a statement and make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question and answer session.

5. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing at the St. Joseph City Hall, 1100 Frederick Avenue, St. Joseph, Missouri, 64501, on Monday, July 9, 2018, beginning at noon.

6. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing at the Clay County Courthouse, 3rd Floor Commission Hearing Room, 1 Courthouse Square, Liberty, Missouri 64068, on Monday, July 9, 2018, beginning at 6:00 p.m.

7. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing at Martin Community Center, Room #2, 1985 S. Odell Avenue, Marshall, Missouri 65340, on Tuesday, July 10, 2018, beginning at noon.

8. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing at Gladstone Community Center, Gladstone/Linden Room, 6901 North Holmes Street, Gladstone, Missouri, on Tuesday, July 10, 2018, beginning at 6:00 p.m.

12. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing at Gregg/Klice Community Center, Large Meeting Room, 1600 East 17th Terrace, Kansas City, Missouri 64108, on Wednesday, August 1, 2018, at 6:00 p.m.

13. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing at Community Center, 200 North Ash, Nevada, Missouri 64772, on Monday, August 13, 2018, at noon.

14. The Commission shall hold a local public hearing at Elk's Lodge Banquet Room, 115 West Franklin, Clinton, Missouri 64735 on Monday, August 13, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.

15. No later than ten days before the local public hearings, GMO shall provide individual notice to each of its electrical service customers including the notice as set out below.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

You are a customer of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company d/b/a KCP&L (“GMO”), which has filed a rate increase request with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”). The Commission has established File No. ER-2018-0146 for this request. The proposed increase is approximately 2.61%. As requested, the bill of the average residential customer would increase approximately \$2.00 per month. Without resetting GMO’s base cost of energy used for its FACs (“Fuel Adjustment Charges”), GMO’s proposed request would be a decrease of about 0.32%.

GMO is asking the Commission to allow it to continue to reflect changes in its fuel and purchased power costs in customer FACs. The FACs base cost of energy gets reset in each general rate case proceeding. GMO’s FACs reflect the difference between GMO’s actual fuel and purchased power costs to serve customers and the base cost of energy, and are billed or credited to each customer based on that customer’s monthly energy usage. GMO is requesting to continue to adjust its FAC rates two times per year, in March and September.

GMO believes the proposed rate increase is needed to recover money spent for several customer experience enhancements, including technology and green initiatives. GMO is also asking to pass along to customers 100% of the savings resulting from the Tax Cut and Jobs Act.

Additionally, Kansas City Power & Light Company d/b/a KCP&L (“KCP&L”) filed a rate increase request with the Commission, along with a request to continue to bill its customers FACs. KCP&L’s customers are receiving similar notices, including the below schedule of public hearings

16. The local public hearings shall be held in facilities that meet the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. 17. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall mail a copy of this order to the county commission of each county in GMO's service area.

18. The Public Policy and Outreach Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this order to members of the General Assembly and to the media that serve GMO's service area.

19. GMO shall place advertisements in the newspapers serving its service territory. The advertisements shall contain the information from the customer notice relevant to the customers in the newspaper's circulation area.

20. This order shall be effective when issued.

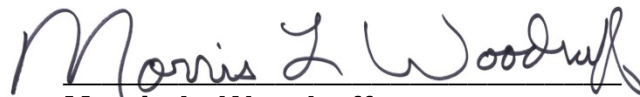
