**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE**

On September 15, 2017, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois filed the above-referenced application. The Commission issued notice of the application, and allowed interested parties to apply to intervene. The Commission received intervention requests from: Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc.; Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri; Neighbors United Against Ameren’s Power Line; International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers; AFL-CIO; Local Union No. 2; and Wind on the Wires.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows ten days for parties to respond to pleadings unless the Commission issues an order to the contrary. More than ten days have elapsed since the applications for intervention were filed, the Commission issued no order to the contrary of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13), and no party responded to those applications.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would

serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed applications, the Commission finds that the applicants meet the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3). Therefore, the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The above-referenced applications to intervene are granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.

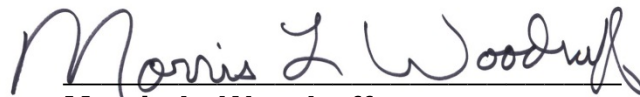
