

The deposit standards used for all applicants who apply for service with the Company will also be used for applicants who apply for service under the Lifeline Program with the exception that deposit requirements will be waived for Lifeline Service applicants who voluntarily elect to subscribe to toll blocking service.
- 25.7.6 Service Charges
 - A. Service charges do not apply when eligible customers with existing residential service convert to Lifeline Service.
 - B. A service order deposit is not applicable to customers who voluntarily elect to receive toll restriction service when initiating Lifeline service.

 - 1. At the time Lifeline Service billing is initiated, eligible residential local exchange access service customers also request additional optional calling features such as Custom Calling Features, ALLST*R features, etc.
 - Any subsequent moves or changes after the initial connection to Lifeline service are requested by the customer.
