A minimum of 50% of the combined total customers in the affected exchanges must vote. At least two thirds of the combined total customers in the affected exchanges voting must vote in the affirmative to discontinue such EAS service.

The survey cards will be returned by the customers to the Secretary of the Public Service Commission for validation and tabulation. The Public Service Commission will advise the Company of the survey results and, if the appropriate requirements are met, the Company will then discontinue such service, together with the appropriate EAS rate additive, as soon as is practicable.

C. A service order charge does apply when:

1. At the time Lifeline Service billing is initiated, eligible residential local exchange access service customers also request additional optional calling features such as Custom Calling Features, ALLST\*R features, etc.
2. Any subsequent moves or changes after the initial connection to Lifeline service are requested by the customer.
3. Service is established for new residential applicants (those without existing local exchange access service) eligible for Lifeline Service. 25.7.7 Payments and Disconnection of Service
