ORDER APPROVING EXPEDITED TARIFF

Issue Date: December 26, 2014

Effective Date: January 2, 2015

On December 18, 2014, Laclede Gas Company issued a tariff to revise the terms of the Residential Direct-Install Low Income Program component of its Conservation and Energy Efficiency Program. The revisions are intended to allow the eligibility requirements for Laclede's gas program to mirror the requirements of the corresponding electric program offered by Ameren Missouri. The tariff revision carries a January 18, 2015 effective date, but, along with its tariff, Laclede filed a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff revision to take effect on January 2.

The Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to Laclede's motion for expedited approval of its tariff do so no later than December 23. The Commission also ordered its Staff to file a recommendation no later than December 23. On that date, Staff filed its recommendation advising the Commission to approve the tariff to be effective on January 2 as requested. No other party filed a recommendation regarding the tariff.

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission finds that the submitted tariff should be approved on less than thirty days' notice.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The proposed tariff sheet submitted under Tariff No. YG-2015-0223 by Laclede Gas Company is approved, effective on and after January 2, 2015. The specific tariff sheet approved is:
