**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET**

Issue Date: March 30, 2022

Effective Date: April 13, 2022

On March 14, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the "Company") filed a revised tariff sheet, Tracking No. YE-2022-0238. The tariff sheet is designed to revise the MEEIA 2019-21 Business Demand Response tariff to maintain consistency with revised Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) Load Modifying Resource requirements. The tariff sheet has an effective date of April 13, 2022.

The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation and set a date for any other responses. On March 21, 2022, Staff filed its recommendation. In its recommendation, Staff stated that the changes would change the maximum number of events in the Business Demand Response program from 10 to 15. Staff stated this is consistent with Staff's previous position that the maximum number of events should be increased and will maintain consistency with revised MISO requirements. Staff recommended the Commission approve the tariff sheet. No other responses were filed.

After reviewing the unopposed tariff revision and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds it reasonable to approve that tariff sheet to become effective on April 13, 2022. So that the tariff may become effective on its April 13, 2022 effective date, this order will become effective in less than 30 days.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Revised tariff sheet, Tracking No. YE-2022-0238 filed on March 14, 2022, is approved to become effective on April 13, 2022.
2. This order shall be effective on April 13, 2022.
