ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

Issue Date: September 20, 2022 Effective Date: October 6, 2022

On July 21, 2022, the Commission issued its Order Approving Transfer of Assets and Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (Order) granting Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) a CCN to operate an existing unregulated water and sewer system in an area of Pettis County, Missouri (Monsees Lake Estates Subdivision). The Order required MAWC to file certain tariff sheets, which were filed on September 6, 2022, and assigned Tracking Nos. YW-2023-0050 and YS-2023-0051. On September 8, 2022, MAWC filed three substitute tariff sheets due to necessary corrections. All tariff sheets have proposed effective dates of October 6, 2022.

On September 13, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed an expedited recommendation affirming that the tariff sheets comply with the Commission's Order. Upon reviewing the pleadings, the Commission finds MAWC's proposed tariff sheets, with three sheets substituted on September 8, 2022, comply with the Commission's Order and will approve them. To accommodate MAWC's chosen tariff effective date, the

Commission will make this order effective in less than 30 days and approve the tariff sheets to become effective on October 6, 2022.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The proposed tariff sheets filed on September 6, 2022, and assigned Tracking Nos. YW-2023-0050 and YS-2023-0051, with three sheets substituted on September 8, 2022, are approved.
 - 2. This order shall be effective on October 6, 2022.
 - 3. This file shall close on October 7, 2022.
