- 0.2.1.3 FRACTIONAL DS1 - A high capacity, point-to-point, digital private line service for data, video and digitally encoded voice communications that transmits simultaneous full-duplex digital signals at data speeds from 112/128 kbps to 1344/1536 kbps in multiples of 56/64 kbps.
- 0.2.1.4 DIGITAL SIGNAL LEVEL 1 (DS1) - A high capacity, point-to-point, private line service that transmits simultaneous full-duplex digital signals at 1.544 Mbps.
- 0.2.1.5 DIGITAL SIGNAL LEVEL 3 (DS3) -A point-to-point, dedicated circuit used for simultaneous two-way transmission of digital signals at 44.735 Mbps. One DS3 channel provides the equivalent information handling capacity of 28 DS1 channels or 672 voice equivalent circuits.
