**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE,
CANCELING HEARING, AND DIRECTING FILING**

On September 30, 2021, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI), filed a motion requesting the Commission suspend the procedural schedule. ATXI relates that the parties have been engaged in settlement discussions and are drafting a settlement agreement that will resolve all the open issues. ATXI requests that the Commission give the parties until October 8, 2021, to finalize and file their settlement agreement or file a status report. The Commission will grant the request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule is suspended until further order of the Commission.
2. The evidentiary hearing set for October 21-22, 2021, is canceled.
3. The parties shall file either a stipulation and agreement resolving the contested issues or a status report no later than October 8, 2021.
4. This order shall become effective when issued.
