Call Forwarding - Busy Line - This feature provides for forwarding of incoming calls to a preselected ESSX-400 station when the called station is busy.

Call Forwarding - Don't Answer - This feature provides for forwarding of incoming calls to a preselected ESSX-400 station when the called station does not answer after a predetermined number of ringing cycles.

Call Forwarding - Variable - This feature allows incoming calls to be forwarded to a preselected station line, within as well as outside the ESSX-400 system.

Call Hold and Call Pickup - This feature allows an ESSX-400 station user to hold any call in progress by depressing the switchhook and then dialing a code, thereby freeing the line for the purpose of originating another call or answering a waiting call. The held call cannot be added to another call. This feature also allows an ESSX-400 station user to answer any call within an associated preset pickup group. If more than one line within the pickup group has an unanswered call, the call that is answered is the one that has been ringing the longest.

Call Transfer - Individual - All Calls, Consultation Hold - All Calls, and Three-Way Calling - This feature allows an ESSX-400 station user to transfer any established call to another station line within or outside the ESSX-400 system, hold any existing call and originate a call to another station line within or outside the ESSX-400 system, and add a third party to any established call for a three-party conference, without the assistance of the attendant.

Call Waiting - Intragroup - This feature allows those ESSX-400 stations with the Call Waiting - Terminating feature to be call waiting on intragroup calls.

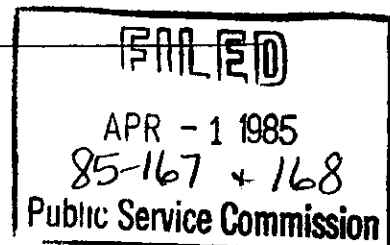
Call Waiting - Originating - This feature allows an ESSX-400 station user to direct a call waiting tone toward a busy called ESSX-400 station. 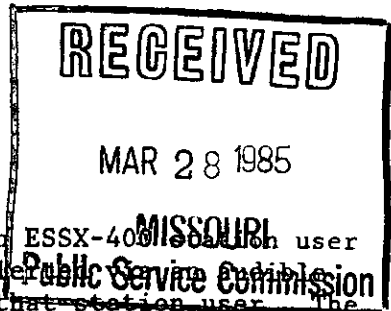

Call Waiting - Terminating - This feature allows an ESSX-400 station user who is engaged in a telephone conversation to be alerted by a tone that an incoming call is attempting to reach that station user. The busy called station can retrieve the waiting call by hanging up and being rung back or by depressing the switchhook to place the existing call on hold and answering the waiting call.

Circle Hunting - This feature provides line hunting in which the hunt for an idle line starts with the called line and proceeds in a prearranged order to all lines in the group.

Conference Calling - Attendant Arrangement - This feature allows an ESSX-400 attendant to connect a maximum of five parties, not including the attendant to a conference facility.

Conference Calling - Station Line Arrangement - This feature allows an ESSX-400 station user to establish conference connections involving up to six conferees, including the conference controller.

Consultation Hold - This feature allows an ESSX-400 station user to hold any call in progress by depressing the switchhook and then dialing a code, thereby freeing the line for the purpose of originating another call or answering a waiting call.

Dial Call Waiting - This feature provides the ability for originating ESSX-400 stations to invoke call waiting service on selected intra-group calls by dialing the dial call waiting access code followed by the extension number of the station to be call waited.

Direct Inward Dialing (DID) - Allows an incoming call to reach an ESSX-400 station without attendant assistance.

Direct Outward Dialing (DOD) - Allows an ESSX-400 station user to gain access to the exchange network without attendant assistance.

Directed Call Pickup - This feature allows for a call directed to an ESSX-400 station line to be answered by another ESSX-400 station user within the same group or system by dialing the pickup answer code and the extension number of the line to be answered.

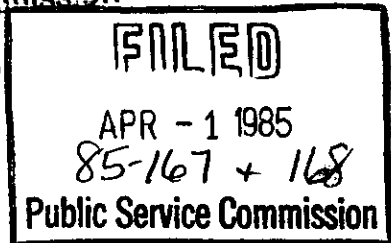

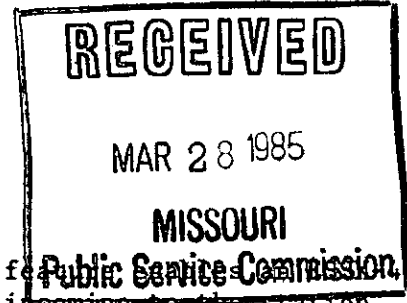

Distinctive Ringing & Call Waiting Tone - This feature allows a station user to determine the source of a call incoming to the station. The station user is also able to determine the source of the call on call waiting calls.

Hunting - Basic - This feature provides hunting for an idle line starting with the called station and ending with the last station in the pre-arranged group, completing the call to the first idle line encountered.

Intercommunication - This feature allows an ESSX-400 station user to directly dial other stations within the same ESSX-400 system without attendant assistance.

Night Service - This feature allows incoming calls normally directed to the attendant to be routed to preselected station lines within the customer group and is activated by the depression of a designated key at the attendant position.

Outgoing Trunk Queuing - WATS - This feature provides efficient usage of business customer private facilities by queuing individual station calls and providing a maximum time limit for a call to remain on queue before possible overflow to the Direct Distance Dialing (DDD) network.

Preferential Hunting - This feature provides a type of line hunting which permits a prehunt over a subset or preferential group of terminals before hunting through the multiline hunt group (MLHG). The hunt through the MLHG can be a regular or circuit hunt.

Remote Access Capability - This feature allows a remote caller access to the features of an ESSX-400 system by dialing the number associated with the incoming facility and an optional security code.

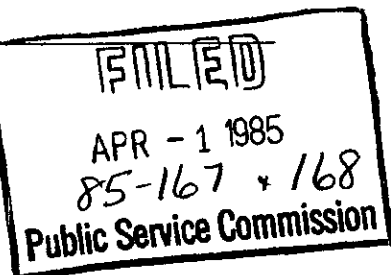
Speed Calling - 6 Codes - This feature allows station users to have abbreviated codes assigned for up to six frequently called numbers. The list of frequently called numbers may be common to the entire ESSX-400 system or unique to each ESSX-400 station line. A common list is controlled by one designated ESSX-400 station line in the ESSX-400 system. Unique lists are controlled by the individual ESSX-400 station lines.

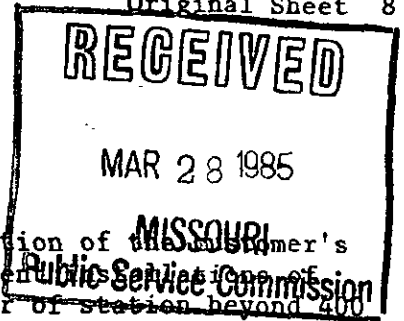

33.2.4 An ESSX-400 basic station and station line facility consist of all facilities, including intercommunication and outside plant facilities from the ESSX-400 dial switching equipment to the network interface at the customer's premises.(1)

33.2.5 ESSX-400 station line facilities are charged in 1/4 mile increments as measured in air miles from the station location to the serving office. The station line facility rates are applicable to ESSX-400 primary and remote locations' station lines which meet the minimum station requirement and any other station lines at alternate locations within the same serving offices associated with the primary and remote locations. The rates apply to station lines in excess of the number of ESSX-400 access lines.

33.2.6 The customer may move ESSX-400 Service within the same serving central office where facilities permit based on cost and subject to the appropriate service connection charges associated with the move. The old contract will not be affected.

33.2.7 The primary location of an ESSX-400 customer served by switching equipment located on Telephone Company premises must be in the same serving office area from which service is furnished.

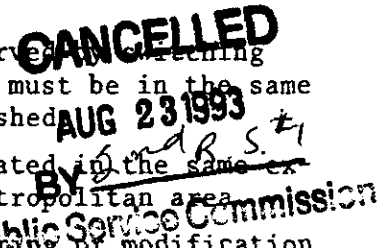
33.2.8 A remote location will be furnished only if located in the same exchange as the primary location or zones of a metropolitan area.

33.2.9 When a customer requests a special service offering or modification of a standard service offering, it will be furnished whenever possible if not detrimental to any of the services or equipment of the Telephone Company. 33.2.10 Directory listings will be furnished in accordance with the regulations set forth in Section 6 of this Tariff.

33.2.11 The assignment of telephone numbers for ESSX-400 shall be in accordance with Section 17 of this Tariff.

33.2.12 Temporary suspension of service in accordance with Section 22 of this Tariff will be provided.

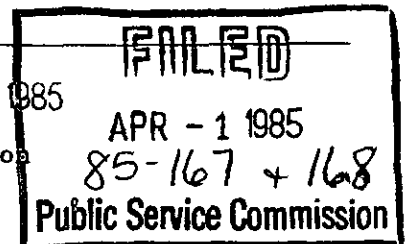

- 33.6.3 One primary directory listing will be furnished with this service in accordance with the regulations set forth in the "Directory Listings" section of this tariff.
- 33.6.4 The assignment of telephone numbers for this service shall be in accordance with the "Rules and Regulations Applying to All Customers' Contracts" section of this tariff.
- 33.6.5 Each station line will terminate in a network interface at the customer's premises. The network interface will be located in designated room(s) on each floor of a customer's premises, except in the case of termination in common equipment where the network interface will be located within 25 feet of the common equipment. The network interface is included in the station line Installation Charge.
- 33.6.6 Sufficient floor space and the necessary wiring, outlets and commercial power for the operation of the service are furnished by the customer who assumes all responsibility for the safe condition of such floor space, wiring, outlets and power.
- 33.6.7 Other facilities, miscellaneous and supplemental service offerings requested by the customer and not detrimental to this service will be furnished in accordance with regulations and at the rate specified in the applicable sections of this tariff.
