ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE REGARDING STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

Issue Date: January 23, 2023 Effective Date: January 23, 2023

On July 7, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a 200 megawatt (MW) solar generation facility located in Audrain and Ralls Counties, Missouri, referred to by Ameren Missouri as the "Huck Finn Solar Project."

On January 4, 2023, Ameren Missouri filed a *Stipulation and Agreement* entered into by Ameren Missouri, Renew Missouri, and the Staff of the Commission (Staff). Paragraph 7.a. on page 3 of the document reads as follows:

Ameren Missouri shall file with the Commission as-built drawings for the Project within 100 days after "Final Completion," as provided for in the BTA [Build Transfer Agreement], provided that, if EDF Renewables is excused under the terms of the BTA from providing certain as-built drawings within said 90-day period, Ameren Missouri will file such as-built drawings within 10 days after receipt thereof from EDF Renewables. Ameren Missouri will notify the Staff within 10 days after expiration of the 90-day period if there are any as-built drawings for which EDF Renewables was excused from delivering within the 90-day period.

Because the above paragraph refers to "100 days" and then refers to the "said 90-day period," the Commission will ask the parties to the *Stipulation and Agreement* to

either explain the reference to "said 90-day period" and confirm that the language of Paragraph 7.a. is correct or file an amended stipulation and agreement with modified language in that paragraph.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Ameren Missouri, Renew Missouri, and Staff shall consult with each other regarding the language of Paragraph 7.a. of the Stipulation and Agreement. No later than January 26, 2023, either Staff shall file a joint response on behalf of the three parties that the language of Paragraph 7.a. is correct and as the parties intended or Ameren Missouri shall file an amended stipulation and agreement modifying the language of Paragraph 7.a.
 - 2. This Order shall be effective when issued.
