ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On July 7, 2022, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to Sections 393.170 and 393.190.1, RSMo. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a 200 megawatt solar generation facility, located in Audrain and Ralls Counties, Missouri (referred to as the "Huck Finn Solar Project") pursuant to a Build Transfer Agreement with EDF Renewables Development, Inc.

The Commission directed notice and set a deadline of August 4, 2022, for applications to intervene.

On August 19, 2022, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) filed an untimely application to intervene. The Commission rejected that application on September 8, 2022. On October 14, 2022, MIEC filed a motion for leave to amend its application to intervene out of time to add a statement of good cause for filing out of time. MIEC also filed an amended application for intervention. MIEC stated that it is "a non-profit corporation that represents the interests of industrial customers in matters involving utility issues . . . includ[ing] the interests of large industrial consumers of . . . Ameren Missouri." MIEC also stated that it has interests that are different from those of the general public and could be adversely affected by actions taken as a result of the decision in this case. MIEC stated that good cause exists to grant its application because the filing was delayed due to the need for client consultation and, because the case is at the early stages, no party will be prejudiced by granting the intervention. No party objected to MIEC's application for intervention.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(10) allows the Commission to grant a motion to intervene after the intervention date "upon a showing of good cause." The Commission finds good cause exists and will grant MIEC's motion to amend and its application for intervention.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. MIEC's motion to amend its application for intervention is granted.
- 2. MIEC's application to intervene is granted.
- 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
