On behalf of The Empire District Electric Company and Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC, I am providing herewith to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for filing, in electronic form, the following revised tariff sheets:

For Empire Electric, PSC Mo. No. 5, Sec. 5, 8<sup>th</sup> Revised Sheet No. 11, Cancelling 7<sup>th</sup> Revised Sheet No. 11; and

For Liberty Missouri Water, PSC MO No. 14, 1<sup>st</sup> Revised Sheet No. 20, Cancelling Original Sheet No. 20.

The redlined changes have been provided to the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel. A similar tariff change will also need to be made for the former Empire Water customers who are now served by Liberty Missouri Water.

These revised tariff sheets are being submitted to clarify that, for AMI opt out customers, the default procedure will be to disable the two-communication portion of the AMI meter. The use of a non-standard (non-AMI meter), so long as available, will continue to be an option for customers. These tariff changes have no impact on rates or charges.
