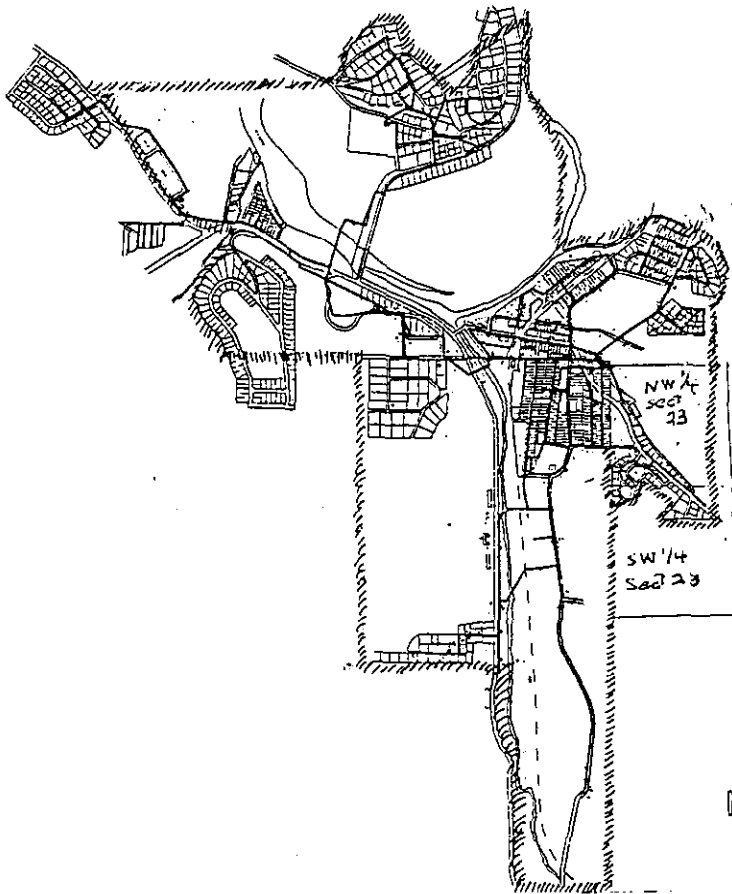

(c) No promises, agreements, or representations of any solicitor or any other employee of the Company shall be binding on the Company unless the same shall be incorporated in a written contract before the same is signed and accepted.

Rule 4 APPLICATIONS AND CONTRACTS FOR SERVICE

(a) A written application for service, signed by the customer, stating the type of service required and accompanied by any other pertinent information, will be required from each customer before service is provided to any unit. Every customer, upon signing an application for any service rendered by the Company, or upon taking of service, shall be considered to have expressed consent to the Company's rates, rules and regulations as approved by the Commission.

(b) All applications for service shall be made in the true and legal name of the person desiring the service. In case of any violation of this provision by an applicant for service, the Company shall have the right to discontinue service to such customer after providing written notice as set forth in Rule No. 7.

(c) If service is requested at a point not already served by a main of adequate capacity, a main of adequate size shall be extended by the Company as may be necessary according to Rule No. 14.

(d) When, in order to provide the service requested, a main extension or other unusual construction or equipment expense is required, the Company may require a special contract for service. Said contract shall specify a reasonable period of time necessary to provide such service. Such contract may require a pre-payment of the Minimum Fixed Monthly Charge for the applicable rate schedule for twelve months to ensure utilization of the new facilities.

(e) Applications for a new connection shall be accompanied by the appropriate connection charge. The connection charge is due and payable in advance of the actual connection, and the Company shall be entitled to at least twenty-four hour's notice for meter installation and service line inspection.

(f) The Company may require a contract committing the customer to service for a period longer than one year when the customer's requirements for water are unusually large and require Company to invest in extra or special equipment or larger than normal piping.

<p>(a) The Company will provide the Customer water service at the outdoor meter, or at the property line. Should it become necessary to place the meter at some other location, any additional expense related to the initial placement of the meter shall be borne by the Company. 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(h) The Company shall have the right to enter the Customer's premises for purposes of inspection to ensure compliance with these rules and regulations. The Company's representatives shall identify themselves and make these inspections only at reasonable hours, except in case of an emergency. The Company shall have the right to remove its equipment and facilities if service is no longer being provided.

(i) Neither Customer's water service lines nor the Service Connection may be extended along public streets or roadways or through property of others in connecting with the Company's mains, except where the service connection is in the water main easement in order to be connected to the main. The service connection and service line must be laid in a straight line and at right angles to the main. Any deviation from this because of physical obstruction will be at the discretion of the Company.

(j) Any customer that has a plumbing arrangement, or a water using device that could allow back siphonage of any chemical, petroleum, process water, water from a questionable supply, or other substance that could create a health hazard or damage to the water system, shall be required to install and maintain a backflow prevention device. This rule may also apply to customers on whose premises it is impossible or impractical for the company to perform a cross connection survey. The device, installation, location, and maintenance program shall be approved by the company. The Customer shall be responsible for the cost of the device, the installation, annual inspection and certification. If the Customer refuses to install the device, the Company may discontinue water service or, at the Customer's request, may install the device and place the amount of the Company's cost therefor on the next bill to the Customer. Failure of the customer to pay such charges shall be grounds for discontinuance of service.

(k) The Customer may purchase and install, at its own expense, a pressure reducing device. The Company shall have no responsibility for maintaining such device. The device is not permitted to be installed in the Company's lines. The device must be located in the customer's service line downstream of the meter.

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Rule 6 IMPROPER OR EXCESSIVE USE

(a) No customer or his agent shall be wasteful of the water supplied to a premises by his willful action or inaction. It shall be the responsibility and duty of each Customer to maintain all piping and fixtures at his unit in a good and efficient state of repair at all times.

(b) No customer or his agent shall make or cause to be made a cross connection between the potable water supply and any source of chemical or bacterial contamination or any water supply not approved by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. The Company shall deny or discontinue service where Customer's Water Service Line or inside piping may, in the opinion of the Company, cause a cross connection with non-potable water or otherwise jeopardize the health and safety of other Customers or the Company's facilities.

(c) No customer or his agent shall make or cause to be made a connection to a device that will result in excessive water demand or excessive shock, such as water-hammer, to the Company's mains.

(d) No customer or his agent shall tamper with, remove, or willfully damage a water meter or attempt to operate the shutoff cock on the meter yoke.

(e) No customer or his agent shall attempt to take unmetered water from the Company mains by an unauthorized tap, direct connection to service connection, by connection to a fire hydrant, or other unauthorized means.

(f) Customers or their agents are not permitted to supply water in any way to premises other than the service address, nor to permit others to use their hose or attachments, nor leave them exposed to use by others without permission from the Company.

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Rule 7 DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE BY COMPANY

(a) The Company reserves the right to shut off services for any of the following reasons:

- (1) Failure to comply with these rules and regulations.
- (2) Nonpayment of utility bill (see Rule 10).
- (3) Resale or redistribution of water service.
- (4) Unauthorized interference, diversion, or water connection to Company

mains.

- (5) Failure to post a security deposit or guarantee acceptable to the Company.
- (6) Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of a settlement agreement.
- (7) Misrepresentation of identity for the purpose of obtaining service.
- (8) Any condition which adversely affects the safety of the customer or other persons, or the integrity of the Company's delivery system.

(9) Pursuant to a Commission-approved agreement between the Company and a municipal sewer system or public sewer district to enforce the payment of a delinquent sewer bill.

(b) In the event that a Customer is in violation of any of these rules and regulations, the Company shall have the right to discontinue service and remove the meter.

(1) Discontinuance of service for the above-listed reasons, when no emergency exists, may occur after ten (10) days' notice to the customer if such notice is sent by first-class mail or after ninety-six (96) hours' notice if written notice is delivered in hand to the customer. The Company shall maintain an accurate record of the date of mailing or delivery of the notice.

(2) At least twenty-four (24) hours preceding a discontinuance, the Company shall make reasonable efforts to contact the customer to advise him/her of the proposed discontinuance and what steps must be taken to avoid it. Reasonable efforts shall include either a written notice following the notice provided for above, a door hanger notice, or at least two (2) phone call attempts reasonably calculated and timed to reach the customer.

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(3) Should Company determine such discontinuance may adversely affect the Customer's health or well-being, Company may give up to twenty-one (21) additional days of notice.

(4) In non-emergency situations, service may be discontinued between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on the date specified or within a reasonable time thereafter. Service shall not be discontinued on a day when utility personnel are not available to reconnect the Customer's service, or on a day immediately preceding such day.

(c) Service may be discontinued immediately without prior notice any time there is a threat to the health and welfare of other customers or a situation affecting the operation or integrity of the system causing the likelihood of major property damage to the system, the public or the customer's premises. Notice to the customer of such emergency discontinuance shall be provided by the Company as soon after the discontinuance as reasonably practical.

(d) Discontinuance of service to a unit for any reason shall not prevent the Company from pursuing any lawful remedy by action at law or otherwise for the collection of monies due from the Customer.

(e) In case the Company discontinues its service for any violation of these Rules and Regulations, then any monies due the Company shall become immediately due and payable.

(f) The Company has the right to refuse or to discontinue service to any unit to protect itself against fraud or abuse.

(g) The Company shall deal with customers and handle customer accounts in accordance with the Commission's Residential Utility Billing Practices, 4 CSR 240-13, where applicable.

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Rule 8 DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE AT CUSTOMER'S REQUEST

(a) Service will be discontinued at the Customer's request, by the Customer giving not less than twenty-four (24) hours notice to the Company during its regular office hours. The Company shall, at the requested time during normal business hours, read the Customer's meter. Charges for water service rendered up to and including the time of discontinuance shall be computed and will become due and payable immediately.

(b) Turn-on of water service so discontinued shall be considered new service and a new application for service shall be required, as provided in Rule 4; provided, however, that no new connection fees shall be payable except for additional service, if any, to the unit.

(c) A customer may request temporary discontinuance of service for any length of time for his own convenience; however, the customer shall still be charged the customer charge (minimum bill) during the time the service is turned off. Turn off and turn on charges are specified in the schedule of service charges.

Rule 9 INTERRUPTIONS IN SERVICE

(a) The Company reserves the right to discontinue water in its mains at any time, without notice, for making emergency repairs to the water system, well, storage, collection system, or station equipment.

(b) Whenever service is interrupted for repairs, all Customers affected by such interruptions will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so. Every effort will be made to minimize interruption of service.

(c) No refunds of charges for water service will be made for interruptions of service unless due to willful misconduct of the Company.

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(d) In order to avoid exceeding the capacities of Company mains and supply facilities, the Company reserves the right, at all times, to determine the limit of and regulate in a reasonable and non-discriminatory manner, and where practical, the maximum amounts of water drawn from the Company mains.

(e) The Company shall use reasonable diligence in providing a regular and uninterrupted water supply, but in case the supply is interrupted or water escapes from the Company's facilities by reason of strike, accident, breakdown, storm, necessary repairs or reconstruction, actions of governmental authorities, or other cause not reasonably in the control of the Company, the Company shall not be liable for damages resulting from same.

Rule 10 BILLS FOR SERVICE; DEPOSITS; ESTIMATES

(a) The charges for water service shall be at the rates specified in the applicable tariffs on file with the Commission. The point of assumption of water service shall be at the property line or outdoor meter setting depending upon whichever is closer to the Customer. Service charges for turn-on of service or turn-off of service are set forth in the Schedule of Service Charges.

(b) A Customer who has made application for water service to a unit shall be held liable for all water service provided to said unit until the Customer notifies the Company in writing to discontinue service.

(c) Deposits: The Company shall have the right at lawful times to require the Customer to make a reasonable deposit, in an amount not to exceed the estimated bill for one billing period plus 30 days, to secure the prompt payment of bills. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum, payable upon return of the deposit, will be paid for the time such deposit was held by the Company unless such period of time be less than twelve (12) months. Such deposits shall be refunded at the termination of service after all charges that may be due and payable by the Customer have been paid or when the Customer has demonstrated prompt payments for service during twelve (12) consecutive billing periods

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and requests same. The Company may require a security deposit or other guarantee as a condition of continued service due to any of the following:

- (1) The service of the customer has been discontinued by the utility for nonpayment of a delinquent account not in dispute.
- (2) In an unauthorized manner, the customer interfered with or diverted the service of the utility situated on or about or delivered to the customer's premises.
- (3) The customer has failed to pay an undisputed bill before the delinquency date for five billing periods out of twelve consecutive billing periods.
- (d) Each Customer is responsible for furnishing the Company with his correct address. Failure to receive bills will not be considered an excuse for non-payment nor reason to permit an extension of the date when the account would be considered delinquent.
- (e) Bills and notices relating to the Company or its business will be mailed or delivered to the mailing address entered in the Customer's application unless the Company is notified in writing by the Customer of a change in address.
- (f) Payments shall be made at the office of the Company or at such other places conveniently located as may be designated by the Company or by ordinary mail. Payment must be received by the close of business on the date due.
- (g) The Company will not be bound by bills rendered under mistake of fact as to the quantity of service rendered or as a result of clerical error.
- (h) A separate bill shall be rendered for each Customer with itemization of all water service charges. Where service is rendered at more than one point of delivery for more than one class of service, each shall be billed separately.
- (i) The Company shall have the right to render bills monthly and such bills shall be due and payable to it no later than twenty-one (21) calendar days from the date of rendition.

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(j) All bills for service shall bear a due date. Bills unpaid after twenty-one (21) days from the date of rendition are delinquent and the Company, after providing the notice specified in these rules and regulations, shall have the right to discontinue all service to such delinquent Customer forthwith, and shall not be required to restore or connect any new service for such delinquent Customer until the unpaid account due the Company under these Rules and Regulations has been paid in full or arrangements satisfactory to the Company have been made to pay said account.

(k) When bills are rendered for a period of less than a complete billing period due to the connection or termination of service, the billing shall be the monthly customer charge (minimum) plus an amount based on the water used at the appropriate rate.

(l) All residential billing matters shall be handled in accordance with the Commission's specified billing practices, 4 CSR 240-13.

(m) **Estimated bills.** The Company may render a bill based upon estimated usage when extreme weather conditions, emergencies, labor disputes or work stoppages, or meter failure or destruction prevents an actual meter reading. In such a situation, the Company shall estimate the bill based upon the reading for the same month for the previous calendar year at the same location. If no such data is available, the Company may utilize the average of the previous and the subsequent month's usage. Alternatively, the Company may utilize an amount for the corresponding month from the billing history of another customer with a reasonably comparable monthly usage pattern.

1. When the Company renders an estimated bill in accordance with these procedures, it shall maintain accurate records of the reasons for the estimate and the effort made to secure an actual reading.

2. The Company shall clearly and conspicuously note on the bill that it is based on estimated usage.

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Rule 11 METERS AND METER INSTALLATIONS

- (a) Except for special situations identified in the Residential Flat Rate Service rate schedule, all permanent service connections shall be metered. The Company's installed meter shall be the standard for measuring water used to determine the bill.
- (b) All meters and meter installations shall be furnished, installed, maintained and removed by the Company and shall remain its property.
- (c) The Company shall have the right to determine on the basis of the Customer's stated flow requirements the type and size of meter to be installed and location of same. If flow requirements increase or decrease subsequent to installation and a larger or smaller meter is requested by the Customer, the cost of installing such meter shall be paid by the Customer.
- (d) Service to any one Customer shall be furnished through a single metering installation. Where a building is occupied by more than one tenant, the building shall be served by one meter. The Customer may rearrange piping at his own expense so as to separate the units and meter his tenants as he chooses, then divide the bill accordingly. A group of buildings or service outlets that are owned by one party may be served through one water meter when, in the Company's judgment, it is practical to do so.
- (e) The meters and meter installations furnished by the Company shall remain its property, and the owners of premises wherein they are located shall be held responsible for their safekeeping and the carelessness of said owner, his agent, or tenant. For failure to protect same against damage, the Company may refuse to supply water until the Company is paid for such damage. The amount of the charge shall be the cost of the necessary replacement parts and the labor cost necessary to make the repair.
- (f) The meter shall be installed at or near the Customer's property line. It shall be placed in a meter box vault constructed by the Company in accordance with its specifications. Company shall furnish and install suitable metering equipment for

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each Customer except where installation in a special setting is necessary, in which case the excess cost of installation shall be paid by the Customer.

(g) The Customer shall promptly notify the Company of any defect in, or damage to, the Meter Setting.

(h) Any change in the location of any existing meter or Meter Setting at the request of the Customer shall be made at the expense of the Customer, and only with the approval of the Company.

(i) It is the responsibility of the Customer or owner of the premises to provide a location for a water meter as near as possible to the property line and which, in the event of water discharge as a result of leakage from the meter or couplings, will not result in damage to property. The Company's liability for damages to any and all property caused by such leakage shall in no event exceed the price of water service to the affected premises for one average billing period in the preceding year. Where damage is caused by the active negligence of Company personnel at the premises, this limitation shall not apply. If a customer refuses to provide an accessible location for a meter as determined by Company, the Company will notify the Public Service Commission before ultimately refusing service or proceeding to discontinue service.

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Rule 12 METER TESTS AND TEST FEES

- (a) Any customer may request the Company to make a special test of the accuracy of the meter through which water is supplied to him. This test will be made in accordance with regulations adopted by the Public Service Commission. (See Meter Test Charge in Schedule of Charges)
- (b) The Company reserves the right to remove and test a meter at any time and to substitute another in its place. In case of a dispute involving a question as to the accuracy of the meter, a test will be made by the Company upon the request of the Customer without charge if the meter has not been tested within twelve (12) months preceding the requested test; otherwise, an approved charge will be made if the test indicates meter accuracy within five percent (5%) more or less.
- (c) A meter test requested by the Customer may be witnessed by the Customer or his duly authorized representative, but the Customer will have to make independent arrangements to view the test at the testing facility to which the meter is shipped since the Company does not test its own meters.
- (d) If a test shall show an average error of greater than five percent (5%), billings shall be adjusted as provided in Rule 13.

Rule 13 BILL ADJUSTMENTS BASED ON METER TESTS

- (a) Whenever any test by the Company of a meter while in service or upon its removal from service shall show such meter to have an average error more than five percent (5%) on the test streams prescribed by the Commission, the Company shall adjust the Customer's bills by the amount of the actual average error of the meter and not the difference between the allowable error and the error as found. The period of adjustment on account of the under-registration or over-registration shall be determined as follows:
- (1) Where a definite period of error can be demonstrated, the adjustment shall be made for such period.

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(2) Where the period of error cannot be reasonably demonstrated, the error found shall be considered to have existed for three (3) months preceding the test.

(b) If the meter is found on any such test to under-register, the Company may render a bill to the Customer concerned for the estimated consumption not covered by bills previously rendered during the period of inaccuracy as above outlined. Such action shall be taken only when the Company was not at fault for allowing the inaccurate meter to remain in service.

(c) If the meter is found to register faster than allowable, the Company shall refund to the Customer concerned any overcharge caused thereby during the period of inaccuracy as above defined. Said refund may, at the Company's option, be in the form of a credit to the Customer's bill.

Rule 14 EXTENSION OF WATER MAINS

(a) This rule shall govern the extension of the Company's water mains after the effective date hereof which are necessary to serve customers within its service area. For purposes of this rule, enlargement or expansion of existing facilities necessary for service to new customers, for which the system was not originally designed, shall be considered an extension.

(b) When a request is made for an extension of water mains, or the Company determines that an extension must be made, the Company shall first determine the closest adequate source of water in its existing distribution system. The Company will then determine the sizes of mains needed and will make an estimate of the cost of the proposed extension. The estimate shall include "estimable costs" such as cost of pipe, valves, fittings, booster stations, storage facilities, other material, necessary reconstruction of existing facilities, construction labor, planning, supervision, inspection, engineering, insurance, tools, accounting expense and other associated direct costs. If it shall reasonably appear that the extension will cause the Company to incur income tax liability, the estimate shall also include concomitant income tax liability. An itemization of the estimate shall be available.

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The estimate shall not include specific amounts for "inestimable costs", i.e. those which are not readily capable of being estimated such as rock excavation, tunneling, and paving, but shall indicate that such are a possibility, and that actual amounts expended for such "inestimable costs" shall be included in the actual and final cost.

(c) If the total estimable cost is less than \$200.00, then the Company will make the extension at Company expense. If the total estimable cost is greater than \$200.00, then the Customer shall pay to the Company the amount above \$200.00 and the Company shall pay the \$200.00.

(d) Prospective customers who desire water service shall apply for service under Rule 4. One or more of the applicants, or the applicants' authorized agent, shall enter into a contract with the Company for the extension of the Company's mains.

(e) Payment of all estimable costs due the Company, as specified in the contract, shall be made prior to initiation of construction and prior to the provision of water service or the acceptance of the facilities as part of the Company system.

(f) The "estimable costs" of the Company's work set forth in the estimate shall be compared to the actual cost of the work done as soon as the work is completed and final cost is ascertained. If the estimated cost of the work in the "estimable cost" category as defined in Rule 14(b) is greater than the completed and final actual cost as ascertained by the Company's accounting department, the Company shall refund the difference within 30 days of such determination. If the completed and final actual cost of the work in the "estimable cost" category is greater than the estimate, the Company shall be responsible for those costs. Applicant(s) shall be responsible for the full payment of the actual costs of the work in the "inestimable cost" category as defined in Rule 14(b) and the applicant(s) shall pay that amount to the Company within 30 days of being billed therefor. If a refund is due from an over estimate in the "estimable costs" category, such a refund may be utilized to offset the amounts due from actual costs from the "inestimable costs" category.

(g) The Company reserves the right to further extend the main and to connect mains on intersecting streets and easements.

Rule 15 FIRE HYDRANTS

(a) Within the boundaries of a municipality or fire protection district, the Company will install, relocate or remove fire hydrants when required to do so by ordinance of an incorporated municipality or direction from the fire protection district. Location of such fire hydrants shall be specified by the designated official empowered to act on behalf of the municipality or fire protection district. The Company may, within its discretion, refuse to install, relocate, or remove fire hydrants if such installation, relocation, or removal is contrary to the recommendations of the Insurance Service Office which are appropriate for the insurance rating for which the municipality or fire protection district is at that time eligible, based upon all factors other than fire hydrants within the municipality or district. The Company may, within its discretion, refuse to install or relocate fire hydrants to locations where there is not an existing water main four inches or larger in diameter. The Company will not install or relocate fire hydrants on private property. Installation or relocation of fire hydrants by the Company shall be subject to the approval of all political subdivisions having or asserting jurisdiction over the installation or relocation of fire hydrants and shall comply with all published standards of such political subdivisions.

(b) Outside the boundaries of a municipality or fire protection district, the Company may install, relocate or remove fire hydrants subject to the requirements of Rule 15(a) and subject to the applicant(s) entering into a contract with the Company providing for the payment to the Company of the costs of such installation, relocation or removal. The contract shall include such conditions necessary to protect the interests of the Company and its customers.

(c) **Rental.** Outside the boundaries of a municipality or fire protection district, the Company may provide fire hydrant service. Such service shall be subject to the applicable requirements of Rule 15(a). Any rental fee shall be agreed to by Company and the applicant(s) and be subject to the approval of the Commission.

(d) Fire hydrants shall not be used by any person or persons other than those designated by the municipality or fire protection district or, in the case of Rule 15(c) situations, the applicant(s), and then such use shall be only for the legitimate purpose of extinguishing fires. Exceptions to this restriction shall be granted only upon written consent by the Company.
