**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING
REQUESTS TO INTERVENE, AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR
FILING RECOMMENDATIONS**

This order directs that notice be sent to all certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications companies in the state of Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. The order also establishes dates for the filing of requests to intervene and for the filing of recommendations.

On September 19, 2006, Fidelity Communications Services I, Inc., filed an application under 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(B)(iv) requesting that the Commission overturn a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. This application concerns a customer's request for 700-800 consecutive Direct Inward Dial numbers to use for a new office building in the Rolla rate center. Fidelity Communications Services I, Inc., indicates that it does not have an available thousands block of numbers available to meet that customer request. Fidelity Communications Services I, Inc., asks the Commission to act upon its application as soon as possible so that it can begin providing phone service to the customer by November 1.

The Commission will allow proper persons until September 29 to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. The Commission will direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. In addition, the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation and will also establish a date by which any other party wishing to respond must file a recommendation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc.

2. Any party wishing to intervene or to request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than September 29, 2006, with:

3. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding Fidelity Communications Services I, Inc.'s application no later than October 6, 2006.

4. Any other party that wishes to file a recommendation regarding Fidelity Communications Services I, Inc.'s Application shall do so no later than October 6, 2006.

5. This order shall become effective on September 20, 2006.
