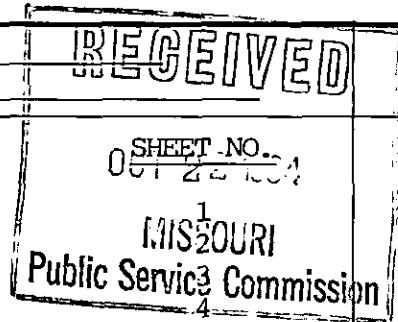

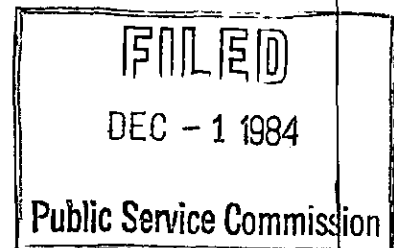

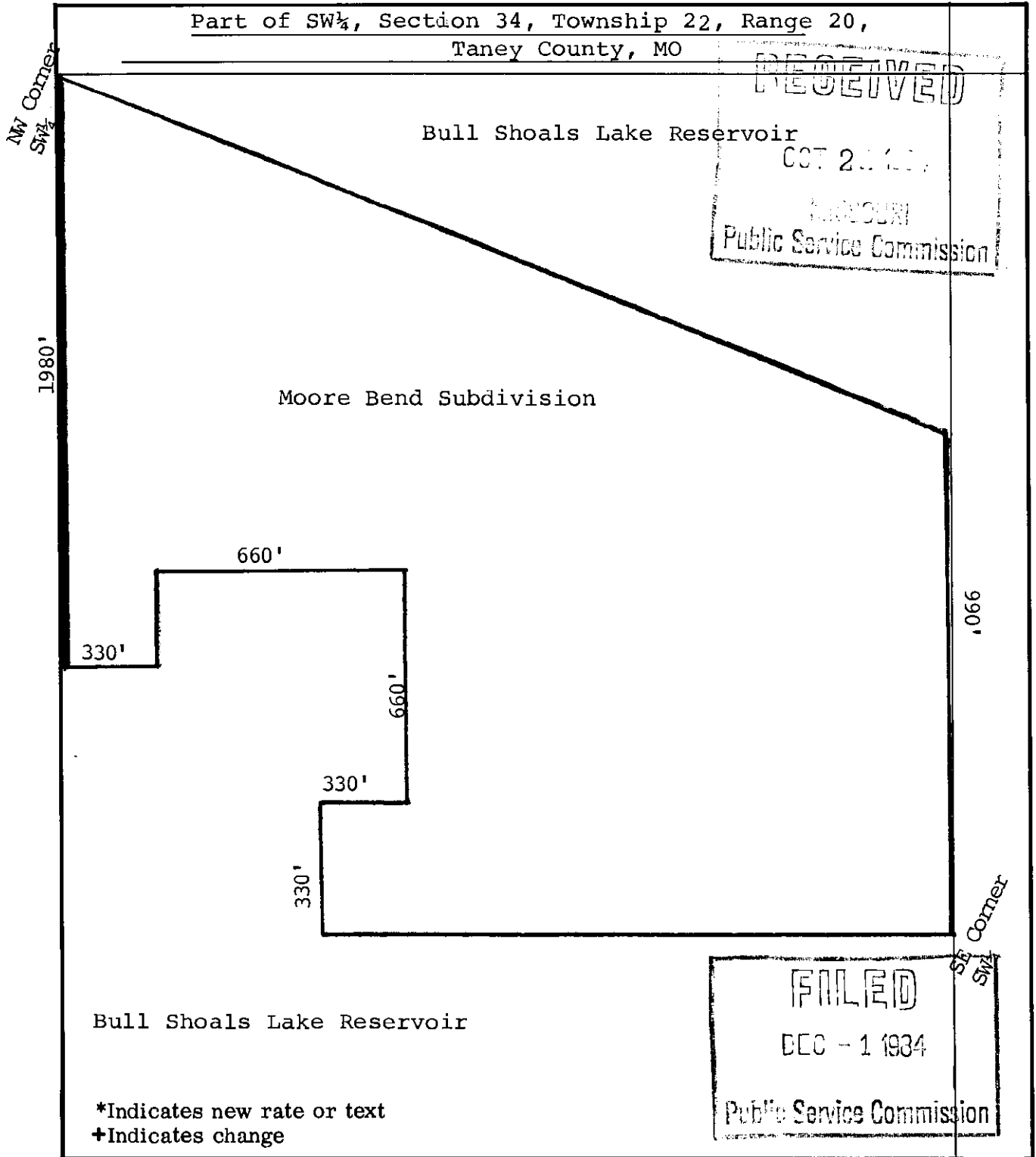

<p>Rule 1 <u>General</u></p> <p>(a) Every customer, upon signing an application for any service rendered by the Company, or upon taking of water service shall be considered to have expressed consent to be bound by these rates, rules and regulations.</p> <p>(b) The Company's rules and regulations governing rendering of service are set forth in these numbered sheets. The rates applicable to appropriate service or rate determination areas are set forth in rate schedules and constitute a part of these rules and regulations.</p> <p>(c) The Company reserves the right, subject to authority of the Public Service Commission of Missouri, to prescribe additional rates, rules or regulations or to alter existing rates, rules or regulations as it may from time to time deem necessary or proper.</p> <p>(d) At the effective date of these rules and regulations, all new and existing facilities, construction contracts, and written agreements shall conform to these rules and regulations in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Missouri and authority of the Public Service Commission of Missouri.</p> <p>(e) No person except an authorized employee of the Company, or other person duly authorized by the Company, shall make any connection to or disconnection from the customer's service line or the water main of the Company. Rule 2 Definitions

MISSOURI
Public Service Commission

- (a) The "COMPANY" is the MOORE BEND WATER COMPANY acting through its officers, managers, or other duly authorized employees or agents.
- (b) The "CUSTOMER" is any person, firm, corporation or governmental body which has contracted with the Company for water service or is receiving service from Company, or whose facilities are connected for utilizing such service at a single address or location, receiving one class of service as follows, (i) a PERMANENT RESIDENT CUSTOMER as used herein shall be understood to be one that maintains their permanent residence at the location served, and (ii) a NON-PERMANENT RESIDENT CUSTOMER as used herein shall be understood to be one that maintains their permanent residency elsewhere than the location served and only occupy such premises on a vacation, week-end or occasional basis.
- (c) The word "UNIT" shall be used herein to define the standard user or property serviced and shall include any residential building, owned or leased. Mobile homes or multi-family properties are considered as separate units for each single family occupying same as a residence.
- (d) A "MAIN" is a pipeline which is owned and maintained by the Company, located on public property or private easements, and used to transport water from point of supply to Company's service connections.
- (e) A "CUSTOMER'S WATER SERVICE" is a pipe with appurtenances installed, owned and maintained by the customer, used to conduct water to the customer's unit from the Company's service connection.
- (f) A "SERVICE CONNECTION" is the connection from the main to the property line, or outdoor setting. This service connection will be installed, owned and maintained by the Company.

Rule 4 Applications for Service

- (a) A written application for service, signed by the Customer, accompanied by the appropriate fees and other information requested by these rules and regulations, will be required from each Customer before service is provided to any unit. Said application must state the name of the owner of said unit. Every Customer upon signing an application for any service rendered by the Company or upon taking of service, shall be considered to have expressed consent to the Company's rates, rules and regulations. The Company shall have the right to reject any application, for failure to comply with the rules and regulations herein. In any case, where unusual construction or equipment expense is necessary to furnish the service, the Company may require a contract for such reasonable period of time as is specified by the Company at the time of the making of such contract.
- (b) If a service connection is requested at a point not already served by a main of adequate capacity, the main shall be extended by the Company as may be necessary, under Rule No. 11. Customer water service shall not be extended along public streets or roadways or through property of others in connecting with mains.

- (a) This rule shall govern the extension of the Company's water mains after the date hereof which are necessary to serve customers within its service area. The Company's water mains can be extended within its service area either by the Company's forces or by an independent contractor in accordance with Company's standards and contractual requirements.
- (b) When a request is made for an extension of water main or the Company determines that an extension must be made, the Company shall first determine the closest adequate source of water in its existing distribution system. The Company will then determine the sizes of mains needed and will make an estimate of the cost of the proposed extension including pipe, valves, fittings, booster stations, standtowers, other materials, and any necessary reconstruction of existing water mains to which the proposed extension will be connected. The estimate will also include the Company's anticipated costs for labor, supervision, engineering, insurance, tools, accounting expense and other overhead expense.
- (c) The applicant or the applicant's authorized agent may contract with an independent contractor in accordance with the Company's standards and contractual requirements. Any necessary reconstruction of existing mains or installation of mains larger than 12 inches in diameter must be done by Company's forces.

1. Installation by the Water Company

If the applicant or the applicant's authorized agent contract with the Company for the extension, the following shall apply:

- A. An original prospective customer is ~~one who agrees~~ to take water service for one year and guarantees to the Company that he will take water service at his existing premises within 30 days after the date water is turned into the main.

***Rule 13 BILL ADJUSTMENTS BASED ON METER TESTS**

(a) Whenever any test by the Company of a meter while in service or upon its removal shows such meter to have an average error of more than five percent (5%) on the test streams prescribed by the Commission, the Company shall adjust the Customer's bills by the amount of the actual average error of the meter and not the difference between the allowable error and the error as found. The period of adjustment on account of the under-registration or over-registration shall be determined as follows:

- (1) Where the period of error can be shown, the adjustment shall be made for such period.
- (2) Where the period of error cannot be shown, the error found shall be considered to have existed for three (3) months preceding the test.

(b) If the meter is found on any such test to under-register, the Company may render a bill to the Customer concerned for the estimated consumption not covered by bills previously rendered during the period of inaccuracy as above outlined. Such action shall be taken only when the Company was not at fault for allowing the inaccurate meter to remain in service.

(c) If the meter is found faster than allowable, the Company shall refund to the Customer concerned any overcharge caused thereby during the period of inaccuracy as above defined. Said refund may, at the Company's option, be in the form of a credit to the Customer's bill.

(1) Upon receipt of a written application for a main extension, the Company will provide the Applicant(s) an itemized estimate of the cost of the proposed extension. Said estimate shall include the cost of all labor and materials required, including valves, fire hydrants, booster stations, storage facilities, reconstruction of existing mains (if necessary), and the direct costs associated with supervision, engineering, permits, and bookkeeping. Applicable income tax cost will be added to this estimate calculated at the maximum rate.

(2) Applicants shall enter into a contract with the Company for the installation of said extension and shall tender to the Company a contribution in-aid-of construction equal to the amount determined in A-1, plus the appropriate customer connection fee. The contract may allow the customer to contract with an independent contractor for the installation and supply of material, except that mains of 12" or greater diameter must be installed by the Company and the reconstruction of existing facilities must be done by the Company.
