ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Issue Date: August 6, 2014 Effective Date: August 7, 2014

On August 1, 2014¹, Missouri Gas Energy, an operating unit of Laclede Gas Company ("MGE") filed a tariff that would revise its Temporary Low-Income Energy Affordability Program ("Program"). MGE filed a substitute tariff sheet on August 6 intended to accomplish the same goal. MGE states that it filed the tariff in accordance with the Commission's Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement in File No. GR-2014-0007.

The tariff sheet bears an effective date of August 31. But MGE filed a motion for expedited treatment along with its tariff. That motion asks the Commission to approve the tariff effective August 7.

MGE states that good cause exists to approve the tariff on an expedited basis. That good cause is that MGE will be able to open the Program to a larger base of customers, and that MGE and its associated community action agencies will be better able to fulfill the intent

of the Program. MGE states that it is authorized to state that the Commission's Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel do not object to the requested relief.

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, and MGE's representation that no party objects, the Commission will approve the submitted tariff on an expedited basis.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet filed by Missouri Gas Energy, an operating unit of Laclede Gas Company on August 1, 2014, as substituted on August 6, 2014, and assigned Tariff No. JG-2015-0041, is approved to become effective on August 7, 2014:
