## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFFS

This order cancels the certificate of service authority and tariffs of UKI Communications, Inc.

On March 23, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission moved to cancel the certificate of service authority and tariffs of UKI Communications, Inc. ("UKI"). In support thereof, Staff stated that UKI, a Missouri corporation, was administratively dissolved on February 19, 2004. UKI's 2004 Annual Report form was returned to the Commission marked undeliverable. Staff stated further that this Commission granted UKI an IXC certificate and approved its tariffs on April 5, 2000, in Case No. TA-2000-544. Staff stated that UKI has not yet filed its Annual Report for 2003 and owes assessments of approximately \$70.00. Because Staff is unable to contact UKI, Staff served this motion upon UKI's Registered Agent. Staff urges the Commission to cancel UKI's certificate and tariff for failure to maintain a current address and telephone number, failure to file annual reports, and failure to pay Commission assessments.

The Commission will grant the requested relief and cancel UKI's certificate and tariff.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Accompanying Tariff, filed on March 23, 2005, by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, is granted.
- 2. That the certificate of service authority granted to UKI Communications, Inc., in Case No. TA-2000-544, is canceled.
- 3. That the tariff of UKI Communications, Inc., Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 1, approved in Case No. TA-2000-544, is canceled.
  - 4. That this order shall become effective on May 2, 2005.
  - 5. That this case may be closed on May 3, 2005.
