## Dear Secretary Woodruff,

Enclosed herewith for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission is the revised tariff sheet, P.S.C. MO. No. 7 Second Sheet No. R-30.13 and revised sheet, P.S.C. MO. No. 8 Second Sheet No. R-30.13 in regards to the Eastern operating division of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire (the "Company"). These revised tariff sheets, have an issue date of August 26, 2020, and an effective date of September 25, 2020, as reflected by the Company's tariff.

In order to better serve our low-income multi-family customers that reside in our Spire Missouri East service territory, we are submitting this revised tariff for your approval. With your approval, it will allow Spire to continue streamlining co-delivery efforts with Ameren Missouri. Spire and Ameren have a utility to utility agreement to work with the third-party administrator Franklin Energy and subcontractor ICast to provide synergies for our shared customers. Spire has revised its tariff language to help customers utilize incentive funding by providing up to 100% of the installed measure cost which is consistent with Ameren Missouri's Gas Tariff language. Spire has also implemented these changes in its Western service territory as part of the Company's co-delivery with Evergy intariff sheet R-30.17. Spire feels these changes will allow the company the flexilibilty needed to spend down funding to help our customers.

No additional funds are being requested outside of the funding we already have budgeted with our EEC Portfolio to operate this revision to the Company's tariff.
