3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected: Applicant proposes to discontinue the affected service in the Kansas City, Kansas and Missouri metropolitan area.

4. Description of Services Affected: The Complete Dynamic ATM service is a flexible bandwidth bundled service consisting of local exchange service with selected features, a Long Distance and/or Toll Free usage allowance of 2,500 minutes, shared web hosting, and Internet access.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers: Applicant sent a written notification of the planned discontinuance to customers utilizing the services in accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules. Customer notifications were sent by first-class U.S. Mail and email on August 11, 2015. A copy of the notification is attached to this application.

6. Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-dominant with Respect to the Service to be Discontinued: Applicant is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

7. Other information: In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules, a copy of this application is being mailed concurrently with its filing to the entities listed on the attached certificate of service. Please direct questions regarding this application to the undersigned.

Conclusion: The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of Applicant's Complete Dynamic ATM services. Advance notice has been provided to all affected customers, giving them ample time to arrange substitute services, which are readily available in Kansas City and include, but are not limited to, other services offered by

Dear Customer,

This letter serves as formal notice that tw telecom (a Level 3 company) will be discontinuing its Complete Dynamic ATM service in the Kansas City (in both KS and MO) metropolitan area. This discontinuance, subject to the approval of the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), will take place on or after 10/05/2015. You are receiving this notice because you currently subscribe to Complete Dynamic ATM services in the affected area. The circuit identifiers of the affected service include: <insert circuit IDs>.

In order to maintain continuous service at your location, we need to migrate your service to another Level 3 service that will best benefit your business or move your service to another telecommunications service provider. If you have not made arrangements with Level 3 or another telecommunications service provider to replace the service listed above prior to 10/05/2015 please be advised that your service will be disconnected on or after 10/05/2015, provided that the FCC approves the planned discontinuance.

If you also subscribe to other services from Level 3, those services will NOT be impacted by the anticipated discontinuance of the Complete Dynamic ATM service. Your other services will remain in place with no change to the applicable rates, terms or conditions.
