ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: March 24, 2006

Effective Date: April 3, 2006

On November 16, 2005, PAETEC Communications, Inc., and American Long Lines, Inc., filed an application for approval of a merger, discontinuance of service, and cancellation of authority, with PAETEC as the survivor.

In Case Number TA-97-363, the Commission granted American Long Lines a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services. American Long Lines' tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, was subsequently approved.

On December 7, 2005, the Commission's Staff filed its Recommendation and Memorandum, recommending that the Commission approve the application and direct the parties to notify the Commission when the transfer is complete.

In its December 20, 2005 Order Approving Merger, the Commission approved the application of PAETEC and American Long Lines, for authority to complete a merger transaction and to discontinue certain operations. The Commission granted PAETEC and American Long Lines a waiver of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-33.150. The applicants were also ordered to notify the Commission of the completion of the merger transaction.

On March 7, 2006, PAETEC filed a Status Report with the Commission, indicating the merger had been completed. PAETEC further requested the Commission accept surrender of and cancel American Long Lines' certificate of service authority in Missouri and cancel its accompanying tariff.

Staff filed its Statement on March 9, 2006, recommending that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority and tariff granted to American Long Lines.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on requests from PAETEC and Staff to cancel American Long Lines' certificate and accompanying tariff, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to American Long Lines shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, granted to American Long Lines, Inc., in Case Number TA-97-363, is canceled.

2. The company's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, Tracking Number JX-2003-1062, granted to American Long Lines, is canceled.
