Rule 1 GENERAL

MISSOURI

Public Service Commission

(a) Every Customer, upon signing an application for any service rendered by the Company, or upon taking of sewer service, shall be considered to have expressed consent to the Company's rates, rules and regulations.

(b) The Company reserves the right, subject to authority of the Public Service Commission of Missouri, to prescribe additional rates, rules or regulations or to alter existing rates, rules or regulations as it may from time to time deem necessary or proper.

(c) The sewer service made available under these rules is for the use of the Customer on his premises, and he shall not re-sell any of it without written consent of this Company.

- (a) The "COMPANY" means L. W. Sewer Corporation.
- (b) The "CUSTOMER" is any person, firm, corporation or governmental body receiving sewer service from Company or whose facilities are connected for utilizing such service.
- (c) A "COLLECTING SEWER" is a pipeline which is owned and maintained by the Company, located on public property or on private easements, and used to transport sewage wastes to a central point for disposal.

The Company will install additional plant facilities and will extend its sewer mains along public highways, parkways, streets or alleys where grades have been established, or within easements acceptable to the Company on the following terms and conditions.

(a) A written application is required from all persons desiring service, as set forth in Rule 3-A. If such service requires the construction of new mains or enlargement of existing mains, the Company shall supply the Customer with an estimate showing the total cost of construction, together with data on any contributions or deposits required in accordance with these rules and regulations. <p>(a) Customers are liable for payment for all sewer service to the premises until notice has been received at the Company's office that the use of the sewer is no longer desired.</p> <p>(b) Bills for sewer services will be mailed or delivered to the Customer's last address as shown by the records of the Company, but failure to receive a bill will not relieve the Customer from the obligation to pay the same. All bills and other accounts must be paid at the office of the Company or other place designated by the Company. 





All taps are to be made by licensed plumbers, subject to inspection and approval by the Company. Application, accompanied by a \$600.00 connection and inspection fee, must be filed in writing 24 hours in advance stating the street, the house number, name of applicant, name of property owner, and time at which tap is to be made. The Company will not be required to supply sewer service until each such tap has been inspected and approved by it. Customer will be liable for any damages to Company sewer mains resulting from such work.

(b) The building sewer service connection from the collecting sewer to the Customer's building shall be installed by and at the expense of the Customer. A service sewer connection shall not be used to supply more than a single property without the consent of the Company.



6. Extensions made under this rule shall be and remain the property of the Company in consideration of its perpetual upkeep and maintenance.
7. The Company reserves the right to connect future extensions to this collecting sewer and the attaching of customers to such further extensions shall not entitle Applicant(s) contracting for the original extension to additional refund.
8. The pipe used in making extensions under this rule shall be of a type and size which will be reasonably adequate to supply the area to be served. Such determination as to size and type of pipe shall be left solely to the judgment of the Company. If the Company desires a pipe size or lift station larger than reasonably required to provide service to the lots abutting said extension, the additional cost due to larger size shall be borne by the Company.
