

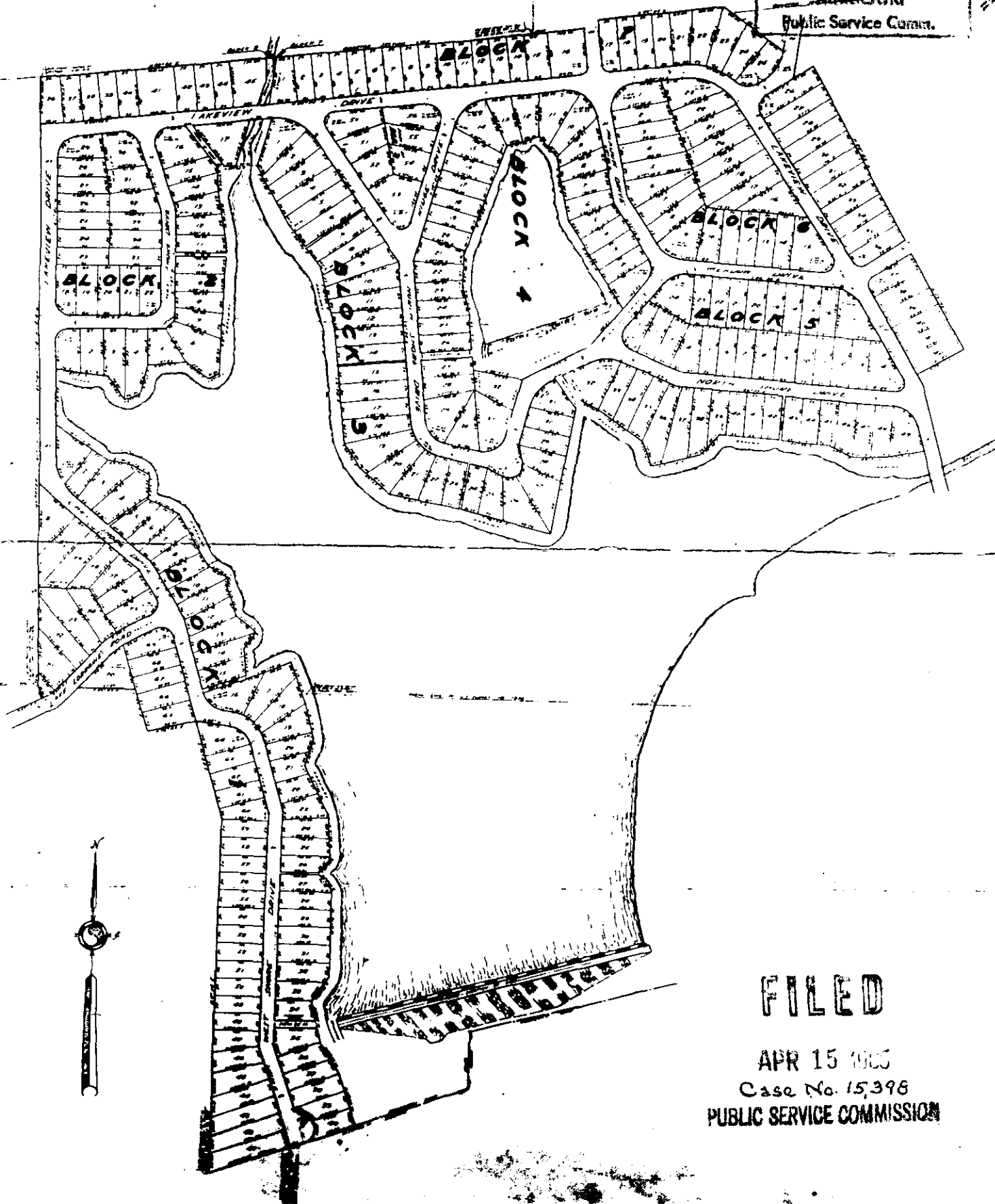

1. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE

Every Customer, before obtaining service, shall execute a written application or contract, upon the Company's standard form providing for service at the rates then in force and effective in the locality where service is to be rendered, and shall be governed by the current Rules and Regulations of the Company on file with the State. An application for service when made by the Customer and accepted by the Company shall constitute a contract. A "Customer" as used herein shall be understood to mean an individual or corporation at a single address or location, receiving one class of service.

2. APPLICATION FOR SERVICE AT DIFFERENT LOCATIONS

A single application for service cannot be made to apply to different locations nor to cover more than one meter or type of service at the same address or location, to be used by the same Customer.

3. APPLICATION MUST BE IN NAME OF CUSTOMER

All applications for service shall be made in the true name of the person desiring the service. In case of any violation of this provision, the Company may discontinue service to such Customer at once.

4. CONDITIONS FOR CONTRACTS

No promises, agreements or representations of any solicitor or any other employee of the Company shall be binding upon the Company unless the same shall be incorporated in the contract and agreement in writing before the same is signed and accepted.

this Company, except those which make a definite exception, are for yearly periods. The Company may require a contract for a period of more than one (1) year with the Customer's requirements for water are unusually large or necessitate considerable special or reserve equipment.

6. CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT

No person except an authorized employee of the Company will be permitted to make taps in the distribution mains. No one other than the employees of the Company shall turn water on to any premises either in the first instance or after the water has been turned off.

The Company may require from any Consumer, <u>Public Service Commission</u> or prospective Consumer, a deposit intended to guarantee payment of water bills. Such deposit shall not exceed the amount of an estimated forty-five (45) day's average bill of such consumer; provided, however, that a minimum deposit of \$10.00 may be required. Interest thereon, as designated by state law, shall be paid to said Consumer annually, and, when service is discontinued and the Consumer makes application for the return of his deposit, Company shall pay said interest on said deposit for the period since the last annual interest payment that such deposit is held by the Company and the Consumer is served, provided such period is not less than six months.		
Rule 20. METERED SERVICE		
(A) The customer shall accept the meter installed by the company as a standard of measurement. Should the meter become defective or fail to register correctly, the quantity used shall be determined by a test of the meter, or by the amount used during a corresponding period of the preceding year, or by an estimate based on the average amount of water used during the preceding twelve months proportioned to the period during which the meter is shown to have been inaccurate.		
(B) In the event of the stoppage or the failure of any meter to register the full amount of water consumed, the consumer will be billed for such period on an estimated consumption based upon his use of water in a similar period of like time.
