ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE
AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: July 23, 2007

Effective Date: July 28, 2007

Syllabus: This order grants Norstar Telecommunications, LLC a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services and approves the company's proposed tariff.

Norstar applied to the Public Service Commission on June 13, 2007, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.440, RSMo 2000.¹ Norstar asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. Norstar is a Virginia limited liability company with its principal office located at 10025 Scenic View Road, Vienna, Virginia 22182.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications for Intrastate Certificates of Service Authority and Opportunity to Intervene on June 19, 2007, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by July 4, 2007. No requests for intervention were filed.

Norstar filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application. The tariff's effective date is July 28, 2007. Norstar's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies Norstar as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested. Norstar intends to provide interexchange telecommunications services.

In its Memorandum filed on July 19, 2007, the Staff of the Commission recommended that the Commission grant Norstar a certificate of service authority, competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff to become effective on July 28, 2007.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange telecommunications market is in the public interest and Norstar shall be granted a certificate of service authority. The Commission finds that the services Norstar proposes to offer are competitive, and Norstar shall be classified as a competitive company. The Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in the ordered paragraph below is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that Norstar's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff filed on June 13, 2007, shall be approved to become effective on July 28, 2007.

The Commission reminds the company that failure to comply with its regulatory obligations may result in the assessment of penalties against it. These regulatory obligations include, but are not limited to, the following:

A) The obligation to file an annual report, as established by Section 392.210, RSMo 2000. Failure to comply with this obligation will make the utility liable to a penalty of

\$100 per day for each day that the violation continues. 4 CSR 240-3.540 requires telecommunications utilities to file their annual report on or before April 15 of each year.

B) The obligation to pay an annual assessment fee established by the Commission, as required by Section 386.370, RSMo 2000.

C) The obligation to comply with all relevant laws and regulations, as well as orders issued by the Commission. If the company fails to comply, it is subject to penalties for noncompliance ranging from \$100 to \$2,000 per day of noncompliance, pursuant to Section 386.570, RSMo 2000.

D) The obligation to keep the Commission informed of its current address and telephone number.

Furthermore, the company is reminded that, if it is a corporation, non-attorneys may not represent the company before the Commission. Instead, the corporation must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri.

In addition, the company is reminded that Section 392.410.5, RSMo Supp. 2006, renders the company's certificate of service authority null and void one year from the date of this order unless it has exercised its authority under that certificate.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Norstar Telecommunications, LLC is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.

2. The certification granted herein is conditioned upon the company's compliance with the regulatory obligations in this order.

3. Norstar Telecommunications, LLC is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:

- 392.240.1 - rates-rentals-service & physical connections
- 392.270 - valuation of property (ratemaking)
- 392.280 - depreciation accounts
- 392.290 - issuance of securities
- 392.300.2 - acquisition of stock

- 392.320 - stock dividend payment
- 392.330 - issuance of securities, debts and notes
- 392.340 - reorganization(s)

Commission Rules

- 4 CSR 240-10.020 - depreciation fund income
- 4 CSR 240-30.040 - uniform system of accounts

4. The tariff filed by Norstar Telecommunications, LLC on June 13, 2007, under tariff number YX-2007-0897, is approved to become effective on July 28, 2007. The tariff approved is:
