Dear Secretary Woodruff:

On behalf of Spire Missouri Inc. (the "Company"), enclosed herewith for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission are the Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider (WNAR) tariff sheets, P.S.C. MO. No. 9, First Revised Sheet No. 13.2 of the eastern Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire ("Spire Missouri East") and P.S.C. MO. No. 9, First Revised Sheet No. 13.5 of the western Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire ("Spire Missouri West").

These revised tariff sheets, have an issue date of March 2, 2022 and an effective date of April 1, 2022 and reflect WNAR amounts that have already been approved by the Commission for 4/1/22 – 9/30/22. With this rate update, for the average residential customer, the overall rates for Spire East will be lower by \$0.30 or 0.55% per month. For Spire West, overall rates will be lower by \$0.05 or 0.47% per month. Such bill impacts may be less or more depending on a customer's actual usage, which is primarily affected by weather.

Thank you for bringing this matter to the attention of the appropriate Commission personnel.
