**ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS
AND GRANTING EXPEDITED TREATMENT IN PART**

Issue Date: March 7, 2018

Effective Date: March 17, 2018

Indian Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. (“Indian Hills”) filed tariff sheets¹ as directed in the *Report and Order*,² and later filed a substitute tariff sheet³ (“compliance tariff”). The compliance tariff bears a proposed effective date of March 23, 2018, but an Indian Hills’ *Motion for Expedited Treatment*⁴ seeks an earlier effective date. Staff filed its recommendation in favor of approving the compliance tariff⁵ and the Commission received no other response within the time allowed.⁶ No evidentiary hearing is necessary to approve the compliance tariff.⁷ The Commission concludes that the
