**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT AND  
APPROVING TARIFFS IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

Effective Date: October 19, 2013

On October 3, 2013, the Commission issued an order approving a Stipulation and Agreement between Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”), KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) (jointly, “Companies”), the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Staff of the Commission. Consistent with the terms of the Stipulation and Agreement and the Commission’s order, KCP&L and GMO withdrew their previously submitted Economic Development Rider (“EDR”) tariffs and filed new tariff sheets that reflected the changes agreed to by the parties. On October 9, 2013, the same day KCP&L and GMO withdrew their original tariff sheets (Tariff File Nos. JE-2014-0026 and JE-2014-0027) they also submitted new tariff sheets to comply with the Commission’s order.

In addition to seeking approval of the new tariff sheets (Tariff File Nos. YE-2014-0167 and YE-2014-0168), Companies filed a motion requesting expedited treatment, so the tariff sheets could go into effect on October 19, 2013. On October 10, 2013, the Commission issued an order directing Staff to file a recommendation no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> of October. The Commission also gave the Office of the Public Counsel till the same date to file a response, should it chose to. Under the terms of the Stipulation and Agreement, all parties agreed to not oppose Companies’ request for expedited approval of new tariff

sheets, if compliant with the terms of the Stipulation and Agreement. Staff filed a recommendation that the tariff sheets be approved and the motion for expedited treatment be granted. The Office of the Public Counsel did not file a response.

Upon review of the pleadings, the Commission finds that KCP&L's and GMO's tariff sheets comply with the Commission's October 3, 2013 order, and will therefore approve them. Furthermore, the Commission finds that good cause exists for the tariffs to become effective in less than thirty days. For this reason, the Commission will approve the tariffs becoming effective on October 19, 2013.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**
