The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued October 17, 2013 to become effective on and after November 1, 2013.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) and Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors for the Company's Missouri service areas.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will decrease from 67.00¢/Ccf to 65.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase from 40.82¢/Ccf to 45.21¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will decrease from 83.00¢/Ccf to 65.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase from 42.07¢/Ccf to 46.46¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The Company is also requesting a variance from certain portions of this tariff so that it may return a portion of the refund over three years to customers in the Rolla area of its certificated natural gas service territory.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing with the copy of this filing being provided to the Staff. Certain of the work papers have been designated "Highly Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its gas supplies. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
